

#### **CHALLENGES**

Low adaptation in Sustainable Mobility

Areas with high seasonal demand

High transport demand at specific periods

Adaptation to residents' needs in the remaining time

#### GOALS

Take Sustainable Urban Mobility Plans (SUMPs) development one step further, focusing in areas with high seasonal demand because of tourism

**Capture and address the needs** as defined by the residents & tourists through the use of technology – social media


Cover the high and low season needs with sustainable transport means


