"2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development"

Exploring pathways of implementation through UNAI and BSEC.

The 1st Meeting of the UN Academic Impact Hubs, from around the world, was held in Athens between 7-11 October 2024, under the chairmanship of UNAI, to promote the 17 Sustainable Development Goals of the "2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development".

The meetings included the **1st Meeting (7.10.24)** of the 17 UN Academic Impact Hubs for Sustainable Development, **the 7th Annual Dinner (8.10.24)** under the auspices of BSEC, the **11th Green Energy Investments Forum (9.10.24)** focused on the promotion of the Sustainable Development Goals and the **17th International Scientific Conference on "Energy and Climate Change" (10-11.10.24).**

Apart from the members of the academic community, the meetings were attended by people with different capacities from the four continents of the planet, mainly in the context of the activities of UNAI, which was also responsible for chairing the relevant procedures.
