
STEPPING MAIN OBJECTIVES

- Adaptat the application of EPC investment for public buildings scheme to

- Raise the competences on EPC for public building of MED public procurers and market players: TRAINING TRANSFERRING
- Involve into project activities the largest audience of stakeholders:
 DISSEMINATE methodologies and results:
 COMMUNICATION



STEPPING MAIN RESULTS

- Prepare 8 investment plan in MED AREA for 85 municipalities
- Launch 4 investment plan in 4 countries
- Train 600 public officers, experts, public procurers on EPC
- Deliver MED guidelines for EPC in public buildings for wider dissemination
